Family Fare

Children aged 12 and under travel for free at any time when accompanied by a fare-paying person.

Paratransit



The fares for these services are the same as the regular transit system, except for the E-wallet, which is not offered due to the absence of a validator in the vehicles.

Therefore, cash payment for these services is charged at the same fare as the E-wallet, depending on the client's category.



Problem encountered when validating your pass

If the fare reader does not accept your card, please use a ticket or cash to pay. A payment receipt cannot be used as proof of a card's validity. Always be ready to have your fare checked. Fraudulent use of a card can lead to its confiscation at any time.
